GARDEN SHEDS

In this Conservation Area, Town Planning Permission is only required for a detached garden shed, green house or other outbuilding if it exceeds 10 cubic metres in capacity. This equates to 353 cubic feet, or a building approximately 8 feet long, 6 feet wide and 7 feet high. Any such building is unlikely to receive approval if it is to be sited in the front garden. Any extension to the house such as a porch, conservatory or any other structure which leans towards the house, will require permission. Consent must also be obtained for the demolition of any building.

DYING TREES

Most residents will by now be aware of the sad sight of many trees, especially the smaller ones planted since the great storm, turning brown and losing their leaves.

It appears that the Council is to blame for carelessly permitting the use of unsafe weedkiller in the spring. - Tony Oliver will be writing to the relevant Department of Ealing Council on behalf of the Brentham residents, to express our dismay and to point out that local residents contributed financially to the replanting of trees on this estate, as in the whole of Ealing. We therefore expect the Council to replace any trees that die, and assurance that such a mistake will not be made again.
