The Brentham May Day is one of the longest running Spring celebrations in the country (118 years old!) and is unique to our little corner of London.

It's a great opportunity for children to be part of their local history and community culture – and they have a lot of fun too!

May Day is open to local children from School Nursery age to Year 9, and involves attending 5 short rehearsals on Sunday afternoons over the weeks leading up to the big day. During these, the children learn Maypole and Country Dances. On the day, the children dress traditionally and parade in the May Day procession through the streets of Brentham behind a big brass band. They return to the Brentham Club field to crown their May Queen, perform their dances for all to see and finally enjoy a delicious tea together!

Enrolment for the May Day takes place on **Sunday 24th March** in the Brentham Club Hall from 4.00 - 6.00pm.

Rehearsals start on Sunday 14th April. The enrolment fee is £20.
